Submit an essay “describing your challenges as a student with a disability and what you have done to overcome it” (Essay should be 1-2 pages double spaced).

Submit a resume.

Submit official transcript.

Submit college acceptance letter.

Each applicant must provide proof of enrollment before funds are dispersed.
